## Cover Sheet:

- 1. READ it
- 2. Follow Instructions

## Exam:

- 1. Be familiar with various testing formats.
- 2. READ the question requirement.
- 3. Follow instructions exactly regarding rounding, format of answer, etc.
- 4. Use T-accounts.
- 5. <u>Use</u> the features of your calculator (like M+, M-).
- 6. For Multiple Choice Question Format:
  - Watch for questions that ask for the INCORRECT or FALSE statement.
    - 1. Read each statement and mark "T" or "F" by it on the exam.
    - 2. Then find the one statement marked "F". This is the correct answer.
  - b. Cover the choices while you read the requirement. Try to answer the question before you have read the choices. Find that correct answer among the choices. (Don't read the requirement 5 times with each of the 5 choices.)
  - c. Guessing. (Hopefully you won't need this tip.)
    - 1. Don't try to find a pattern on the answer sheet. (I've used "c" three times in a row prior to this question. Surely this answer can't be "c" also.)
    - 2. Use process of elimination.
    - 3. Choose your favorite letter for a blind guess TODAY.
- 7. Mark the questions on the exam that you want to come back to during the time you save for review.
- 8. During your review time, use an alternate formula or "back door" approach to confirm your answer. Use common sense approach.

## Answer Sheet:

- 1. It is <u>recommended</u> that you use capital letters.
- 2. Write your letters and numerals in a consistent manner.
- 3. Write legibly. If the graders cannot read the answer, it is
